



**SUGGESTED CLOTHING LIST FOR YOUR ALASKAN HUNT...SPRING OR FALL
(Please use what you prefer on type of materials for clothing i.e.
polypropylene verses cotton, thinsulate versus wool, etc...)**

Leave your cotton at the lodge!

1. 1 warm coat
2. 1-2 pair of wool, Gore-tex, Cordura, or non – cotton trousers
3. 2-3 wool or pile shirts (wind stopper material works well)
4. 1-2 wool or polypropylene long underwear (tops & bottoms)
5. 6 pair light wool or polypropylene socks
6. 4 pair heavy wool socks
7. Enough lightweight underwear & handkerchiefs for duration
8. 1 pair hiking boots
9. 1 pair ankle fit hip boots
10. 1 pair camp shoes or tennis shoes
11. 1 rain coat insulated or non insulated with hood and rain pants
12. 1 pile vest or heavy wool sweater
13. 1 hunting cap with ear flaps or wool stocking cap
14. 1 pair gloves
15. 1 pair binoculars 7x35, 8x30 or 10x40
16. 1 rifle and 2 boxes ammo – 338 Win Mag. or larger caliber for brown bear.
Moose 300 Win Mag. is adequate
17. BEAR HUNTERS 1 pair insulated coveralls (optional)
18. Personal gear – toiletries, knife, medication, etc...
19. 1 day pack (large enough to hold rain gear, coat camera. Etc...
20. 1 sleeping bag – 5 + 30 degree comfort range (with stuff sack)
21. **WE will supply all safety equipment:** e.g. radios, first aid kits, emergency locator beacons, etc...

All outer clothing should be solid colors or camouflage.

Any of the above gear can be purchased in Anchorage. If you have difficulty walking or climbing because of arthritis, bad knees or bad ankles please advise me so I can take measures to accommodate you.

Stay away from cotton; leave your Levi's at home. I personally hunt in all synthetic clothing, right down to my underwear!
